Students that complete the Marine Services program are positioned to enter the job market in entry-level positions and assistant positions. Students will also be able to successfully transition into one of Skagit Valley College's Professional/Technical Programs: Marine Maintenance and Repair, Composites Technology or Manufacturing.

- * Teaming or consulting with other industry professionals, teachers, and support staff
- * Interactive learning software and other forms of technology
